

Two days specialized Training on Performance Assessment of Islamic Microfinance Institutions

A two days specialized training on performance assessment of Islamic microfinance institutions was jointly organized by Centre for Excellence in Islamic Finance (CEIF), IMSciences, Peshawar and Islamic Microfinance Network (IMFN) – a subsidiary of Akhuwat in Royal Palm Golf and Country Club Lahore.
