

IMSciences Institutional Scholarship Award Committee (ISAC) approved 53 Fully Funded Scholarships amounting Rs. 53.07 million

The IMSciences Institutional Scholarship Award Committee approved a total of 53 fully funded scholarships amounting Rs. 53.07 million for the financially needy and talented students from 29 districts of KP including NMDs, who recently have secured admission at the Institute of Management Sciences Peshawar in nine (9) Undergraduate and eight (8) Graduate Level Programs Session 2023-2027 under HEC, IMSciences NMDs (Ex FATA) and Chief Minister Education Endowment Fund (CMEEF) Need Based Merit Scholarship Programs.

Prof. Dr. Usman Ghani welcomed the panel and thanked the HEC, Islamabad, Directorate of Merged Areas and Higher Education Department Govt of KP for their exemplary initiatives of generous funding to the most deserving and talented students of the Institute. He mentioned that IMSciences has rich culture and history of financial aid management, since 2004 the Institute has provided financial assistance of Rs. 2.124 Billion to more than 10,000 students. He also mentioned that in the last Financial Year 2022-2023, with the cooperation of such donors, the IMSciences is enabled to invest Rs. 237.821 million for the benefit of 1641 students, currently enrolled in 17 different study disciplines. He elaborated that all these efforts is the result of donor recognition procedures and team work culture at the Institute, which clearly distinguish itself by making education a right rather than a privilege.

The committee was further briefed by the Grants Manager that in current year, a total of 247 candidates applied from 29 different regions from KPK including NMDs. All the members took a keen interest in reviewing the recommended cases thoroughly, interviewed these candidates and consensually approved a total of 53 candidates for fully funded scholarship awards, amounting Rs. 53.07 million. The Director IMSciences, Prof. Dr. Usman Ghani and other donor representatives guided the recommended students to set clear goals and objectives in their student life, to contribute for the socio-economic development of Pakistan.
