**Meeting Minutes:** Mr. Sajid Fahim, the Project Lead, welcomed the participants to the pre-bid meeting. He provided a brief explanation of the assignment's scope before opening the forum for questions.

During the pre-bid meeting, the following queries were raised by the attendees, which were addressed accordingly.

- An inquiry about the necessity of obtaining a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the Commissionerate Afghan Refugees (CAR) was raised because the assignment involves training Afghan refugees. It was clarified that IMSciences – HRDC has already secured the NOC, relieving participating firms of this requirement.
- Participants sought clarification on the logistics for training participants. It was communicated that IMSciences – HRDC will manage all logistics related to the training participants. However, consulting firms are responsible for coordinating logistics for their respective trainers. In addition, it was also clarified that arrangements for the food and venues will be the responsibility of IMSciences – HRDC.
- Participants inquired about the language of the manual. It was responded that the manual will be in English, with a requirement for Urdu translation. The responsibility for Urdu translation lies with the consulting firm.
- A query was raised regarding any guidelines for the manual. It was responded that while basic information is available in the Terms of Reference (TORs), detailed guidelines will be discussed in depth once the selected firm is onboard.
- Another participant raised a query related to the ongoing repatriation process of Afghan Refugees
  and whether the repatriation of Afghan Refugees will affect the assignment. The Project Lead
  informed the participants that any issues related to repatriation/deportation will be addressed by
  CAR, GIZ, and IMSciences-HRDC. The process of repatriation/deportation will not affect the
  assignment.
- Participants sought clarification regarding the template for the Technical Proposal. It was clarified
  that participating firms are permitted to use their own templates; however, it was emphasized that
  the information layout and content must align with the Technical Evaluation Criteria outlined in the
  Terms of Reference (TORs).
